3000 Small Business Owners Expected to Attend September 17-19th

Three thousand small business owners from across the country are expected to attend the U.S. Small Business Administration's National Entrepreneurial Conference & Expo (NECE), in Washington, D.C., Sept. 17-19, 2003, at the Washington Hilton & Towers Hotel, the cornerstone event marking the SBA's 50th anniversary.
