Small Businesses Use Their Computers Surfing for Information at WWW.SBA.GOV/WY

The Small Business Administration's (SBA) web site provides a wealth of information for existing small businesses and potential entrepreneurs. The site offers "startup" assistance on developing business plans, market research and getting startup counseling and training from SBA and its resource partners. Local calendars of training courses and seminars throughout Wyoming can be found at "special events" area on the www.sba.gov/wy site.

Information on SBA loans or general access to capital are available in the "financing" area. Online business opportunities can be found under "opportunities" for getting government contracts through SBA's Procurement Network (PRO-Net). Small businesses located in historically underutilized business zones (HUBZones) can register online to qualify for special opportunities for federal procurement and contract opportunities. The "laws and regulations" area offers a link to SBA's Wyoming Businesslaw.gov for legal and regulatory help. State economic profiles are available for 2000, 2001 and 2002.
